President's Report



New Zealand thoroughbred breeders have a great deal to be proud of when we review the major racing achievements of Kiwi-bred horses around the world over the 2016/17 season, culminating in the success of our horses at the Sydney Autumn Carnival with outstanding efforts at the highest level by Jon Snow, Bonneval and Gingernuts.

In the highly competitive racing environments of Australia, Singapore and Hong Kong, horses bred in New Zealand continue to display the class, courage and durability for which the (NZ) bred has long been famous. New Zealand breeders deserve even more accolades because they are producing these horses within a domestic racing industry which currently offers little encouragement for new investment.

The Karaka yearling sales were again a reality check for the New Zealand breeding industry especially when compared to the sales series in Australia, where healthy increases and clearance rates were achieved. The lack of demand for our fillies in the Select and Festival yearling sales emphasised the lack of depth in the domestic market. This trend continued in the recent broodmare and weanling sale. That said, it is reassuring to know that there is still demand from the international buying bench for our quality horses.

The entire thoroughbred industry welcomed the long awaited announcement in April by the New Zealand Racing Board that there would be an injection of \$13m into thoroughbred stake money over the next two seasons. This is a start and should enable breeders to have greater confidence in the future of our thoroughbred industry.

It is also very pleasing to see new investment into the breeding industry by studs standing new stallions for the 2017/18 season. There are a number of new quality stallions available to breeders this season to complement the success of a number of our established stallions.

FINANCE

The Association made a loss of \$22,154 after tax compared to a surplus of \$13,870 last year.

The main reason for this turnaround was a decline in members' subscriptions – a decline of \$16,590 following on from an increase in the previous year of \$19,140 (mainly due to an increase in the subscription fee in 2016). This decline is of major concern to your Association as more members resign as their

involvement in thoroughbred breeding and racing comes to an end.

Secondly, our CEO has completed 20 years of service and hence is entitled to an additional six weeks paid leave. This long service leave entitlement has been accrued into the 2017 financials.

Cash in the bank and on deposit as at 31 March 2017 totalled \$318,819. We are budgeting for a small surplus for the year 2018.

I wish to acknowledge the continued support from our loyal commercial partners, Dunstan Nutrition, Fertco, Bank of New Zealand, Goldpine, Magnum Industries, OFX and Braithwaite & Pearks. We welcome aboard FastTrack Insurance as a new partner, and encourage members to utilise all our partners' services.

MEMBERSHIP AND BRANCHES

For a number of years now we have experienced a decline in membership numbers. Unfortunately our efforts to enrol new members is unable to maintain previous years' numbers. The majority of resigning members are no longer involved in breeding horses, and most have thanked the Association for its past service and benefits.

I cannot stress enough how important our Branch structure is. Once again, I wish to record my genuine thanks to all those elected officers who so willingly give their time and expertise for the benefit of our members and keep their regional branch alive and well. The future of our Association lies in the strength of our branch membership. I also take this opportunity to thank all current financial members for their continued support of the work the Association does on your behalf.

BLOODSTOCK TAXATION

As mentioned in last year's President's Report, after two years consultation with the IRD, there were some issues we continued to disagree on; specifically the non-availability of write downs for a new investor until the horse commences breeding.

With the valuable assistance of the New Zealand Racing Board we have jointly made submissions to the Revenue Minister for amending legislation to be introduced into Parliament. This has also involved lobbying various Cabinet Ministers to gain their support for the proposed changes. This process has involved more meetings and submissions with the Inland Revenue Department.

I hope the outstanding issues can be brought to a conclusion before the upcoming General Election. I wish especially to thank John Aubrey for his knowledge and passion in advising on these tax matters.



HEALTH AND SAFETY

The new Health and Safety at Work Act 2016 became law in New Zealand on 4 April 2016. The Association has been involved in educating and informing members and industry stakeholders about their responsibilities under the new Act including, Guides to Managing Risk around horses, Staff and Contractor Induction, and the Safer Farms Toolkit. An extensive library of information and helpful advice is available on the NZTBA website and additional assistance can be sought through our Cambridge office if required.

NEW ZEALAND THOROUGHBRED MARKETING (NZTM)

The Council is currently represented on the NZTM Board by John Thompson, and the Studmaster Branch by Rodney Schick and Simms Davison. I thank them, as well as Chairman Chris Weaver, Andrew Birch CEO, and Tara Hughes, for their success in the generic promotion of the New Zealand thoroughbred to the world.

It was pleasing to complete our website upgrade in association with NZTM during the past year. The combined website presence for both NZTM and the NZTBA remains our strongest communication tool for new and existing breeders and investors.

Paul Vettise continues to head up a strong team of contributors to the NZ Racing Desk and their well presented stories have highlighted New Zealand's success both locally and internationally. Without this initiative we would read very little about thoroughbred racing and breeding in our local newspapers or online.

With strong and organised competition from Australia for the international buying bench, it is essential that NZTM and New Zealand Bloodstock work closely together to protect and develop our mature markets, and then in turn develop new opportunities to expand the international market.

EQUINE HEALTH ASSOCIATION (NZEHA) AND THE EQUINE RESEARCH FOUNDATION (NZERF)

The NZTBA continues to be represented on the NZ Equine Health Association (NZEHA) by our CEO Michael Martin.

The Association would like to thank and recognise the time and effort put into the NZEHA by Chairman, Dr Ivan Bridge, and Executive Advisor, Dr Patricia Pearce. Without their dedication to the many issues that arise related to Equine Health, New Zealand would be very exposed in such an international industry of horse movements. Having representatives from all the equine groups around one table, responsible for communicating directly with the Ministry of Primary Industries and the Director General, is very important for all horse owners in New Zealand.

Late last year the Ministry (MPI) hosted a two day Forum in Auckland, named Biosecurity 2025, which was attended by members of the Equine Health Association including our Chief Executive. There was a wide range of topics discussed, so it is of vital importance that the equine industry remains part of the future biosecurity initiatives for New Zealand.

During the past year the NZEHA has been working to alter the conditions of use of the genetically modified Equine Influenza (EI) vaccine Proteq, to allow its use in all horses leaving New Zealand where EI vaccination is an important country requirement. Such use will better enable the establishment of an EI vaccine bank that may be an essential element in responding to an Equine Influenza outbreak in New Zealand.

The NZTBA also acknowledges the work of the New Zealand Equine Research Foundation (NZERF) under the guidance of Chair, Dr Margaret Evans, Vice Chairman, Dr Tim Pearce and Secretary Allan Fenwick. During the past year, the trustees have welcomed the Rodmor Charitable Trust as their new sponsor of the Foundation's Bulletin and Annual Lecture Series. The Rodmor Charitable Trust was formed following the deaths of Jim and Veda Morris who founded the well known Rodmor Stud in Cambridge.

The Foundation ran a series of very successful veterinarian and farrier clinics during the year as well as supporting its growing number of Scholarship opportunities including the Valachi Downs Young Achiever Award, and the new Jonathan Hope Young Equine Veterinarian Scholarship. This is in addition to its core business of granting applications of research grants from many New Zealand researchers, who are doing some outstanding work on behalf of the equine industry.

EDUCATION

We are pleased to advise that New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing (NZTR) is becoming more involved with industry education as they recognise the importance of student training. This not only involves breeding industry staff, but also apprentice jockeys and stable hands.

This closer involvement is timely as we are due to review our breeding qualification and test whether it is "fit for purpose". This will be done in conjunction with stud owners, students and their employers, as well as industry participants such as vets and farriers.

Twenty breeding industry students recently attended various lectures as part of a three day block course held in the Waikato region. Information on this course will be on the NZTBA Facebook page and featured in the next edition of the Breeders' Bulletin.

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2017

NZTBA EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Bevan Smith was awarded the 2016 Sunline Trust International Management Scholarship. On his return to New Zealand in October 2016, he joined Guy Mulcaster Bloodstock. Hannah Mee, the winner of the Irish National Stud course, returned to Trelawney Stud after her summer placement there. We wish both Bevan and Hannah every success in the careers ahead of them.

The 2017 Sunline International Management Scholarship was awarded to Lance Forbes, the yearling manager at Cambridge Stud. Lance is currently at Coolmore Stud in Ireland, half way through the nine month Scholarship taking him to three different countries.

The 2017 Irish National Stud scholarship, generously supported by the Keith & Faith Taylor Equine Scholarship, was awarded to Cameron Ring from Waikato Stud. Cameron is currently making the most of his opportunities in Ireland and his monthly Blog on www.nzthoroughbred.co.nz is an interesting account of life at the Irish National Stud.

CONSTITUTIONS

The NZTBA, and nearly all its branches, operate under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. The Act is now more than 100 years old and requires updating to help volunteers govern and administer a Society in today's conditions.

The Government is working towards introducing a Bill to Parliament next year to implement modern legislation that will help guide Incorporated Societies into the future. As a result of NZTR's assistance and encouragement, Race Clubs and Sector Groups are updating their Constitutions in anticipation of the new law, and the need for modern, robust Constitutions to govern themselves. The Association has undertaken an exercise to do this for both the National Body, and its branches.

With the approval of the Council and branches, it is intended to present the two new Constitutions to the Annual General Meeting this year so that our Association will be operating under modern workable rules at both National and Branch level.

My thanks to both NZTR, for their financial assistance to get the base National Constitution updated, and to Michael Martin and the branch committees, for their work in developing the best solutions to create a template that all branches can agree to have as their new Constitutions.

NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES

The Pearl Series is now in its fifth year of enrolments. The Series continues to be a success story for owners of fillies and mares, with owners and trainers targeting the many Pearl races that are programmed throughout New Zealand.

Congratulations to each and every winning owner who has enjoyed their filly's success. Bonuses are paid through NZTR's Owners' Settlement account and again I wish to record my appreciation to NZTR for their assistance in this regard. Many winners have reported that the Bonus payment has made a very big difference in making their racing year a success.

Early Bird enrolments for the 2017 Series closed on 17th March 2017 with 283 fillies enrolled.

Entries are still being taken for the 2017 Series up until 31st July with an entry fee of \$1,320 inc. GST.

My thanks to New Zealand Bloodstock Insurance for their continued support in sponsoring the Series, and to Michael Martin and Nicola Griffiths for their management and promotion of the Pearl Series. I would also like to acknowledge Vicki Pascoe and Richard Wright for their on course attendance and assistance with promotion.

COUNCIL AND STAFF

I wish to thank Council members for their support and input to the Association. We have not met as often as in previous years in an endeavour to keep costs down, but there has been plenty of behind the scenes input from all members, especially the Executive Team who have been focused on some key issues for the Association and its future. I particularly wish to thank Vicki Pascoe for the time and effort she has put into the Education portfolio and the development of more relevant courses this year.

My appreciation is extended to our CEO Michael Martin who has served the Council and its members in his usual committed manner again this year. He has spent many hours working on updating the Association's Constitution and developing a workable template for the Branches to operate under. Also my thanks to our Office Manager, Nicola Griffiths for her input, especially in the efficient handling of the Pearl Series administration and the finance portfolio.

We are committed to our office being based in the Waikato, but we urgently need to find a solution to reducing our cost structure to make the Association more efficient. We also need to raise awareness regarding the positives of breeding thoroughbred horses and how people can get involved. We need to improve communication with members by the better utilisation of digital and other modern methods to respond to this 'instant' world.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Members of New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Association (Inc.)

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of *New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders'* Association (*Inc.*) which comprise the statement of financial position as at 31 March 2017, the statement of financial performance and the statement of movement in members' equity for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

In our opinion the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects the financial position of the *New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Association (Inc.)* as at 31 March 2017 and its financial performance for the year then ended in accordance with the Special Purpose Framework for use by For-Profit Entities published by the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (New Zealand) (ISAs (NZ)). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements* section of our report. We are independent of the entity in accordance with professional and Ethical Standard 1 (Revised) *Code of Ethics for Assurance Practitioners* issued by the New Zealand Auditing and Assurance Standards Board, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Our firm has assisted in the preparation of the annual tax return for the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Association (Inc.) Other than this we have no relationship with, or interests in, New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Association (Inc.).

Emphasis of Matter - Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Distribution

We draw attention to Note 1 to the financial statements which describes the basis of accounting. The financial statements are prepared for the members and the Inland Revenue Department. As a result, the financial statements may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report is intended solely for the entity and its members and should not be distributed to parties other that the entity or its members. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Council's Responsibilities for the Financial Statements

The Council is responsible for the preparation of the financial statements in accordance with the Special Purpose Framework for use by For-Profit Entities and for such internal control as the Council determine is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, the Council is responsible on behalf of the entity for assessing the entity's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Council either intend to liquidate the entity or cease operations, or have no realistic alternative but to do so.

Auditor's responsibilities

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with ISAs (NZ) will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

Notes to the Accounts

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2017

NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1.1 Statement of Accounting Policies

The entity reporting is New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Association (Inc.) (NZTBA), which is registered under the Incorporated Societies Act (1908). The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the Special Purpose Framework for use by For-Profit Entities (SPFR for FPEs) published by the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants.

1.2 General Accounting Policies

The measurement base adopted is that of historical cost.

1.3 Particular Accounting Policies

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE

Accounts receivable are stated at expected realisable value. Provision has been made for bad debts where considered necessary.

FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION

Fixed Assets are recorded at cost and with the exception of the Library, have been depreciated at maximum rates allowable by the Inland Revenue Department for taxation purposes. These rates are considered appropriate for the purposes of these financial statements. The Library is not depreciated. Depreciation rates used are shown below:

Fixtures & Fittings 20%DV

Office Equipment 33% - 48% DV

Motor Vehicle 26%DV

INCOME TAX

The Association adopts the taxes payable method of accounting for income tax.

The income tax expense for the period is equal to the income tax payable for the same period. The income tax effects of timing differences are not recognised.

Income and expenditure directly attributable to the membership of the Association is non-assessable for taxation purposes.

Income tax benefits arising from income tax losses are only recognised where there is virtual certainty of their realisation.

OPERATING LEASES

Operating lease rentals are recognised evenly over the expected period of benefit to the Association.

SUBSCRIPTION REVENUE

The subscription year runs from 1 April to 31 March. Income from subscriptions is taken up on a cash received basis.

GST

GST is accounted for on a payment basis. Revenue and expenses are shown net of GST.

1.4 Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in the above accounting policies which have been applied on bases consistent with those in previous years.



NOTE 2: FAMIS TERM DEPOSIT

The Association's FAMIS incentive scheme was started in 1992 and finished on 31 July 2006. The residual Bonus pool held at that date was \$107,525. In 2006 the Council resolved that the residual pool be retained and applied to future racing/breeding projects. In March 2013, the Council resolved to transfer \$7,525 from this fund to the new Pearl Series Bonus Scheme to assist the launch and promotion of the Series. In March 2014 the Council resolved to transfer \$10,000 from this fund to assist the Association with the moving costs associated with the abandonment of the NZTBA office at Ellerslie Racecourse. At balance date the residual fund is now \$90,000. This is secured by a corresponding amount on Term Deposit at the Bank of New Zealand, Matamata Branch. The FAMIS fund balance is not reflected in the Association's Statement of Financial Position.

NOTE 4: PURPOSE OF OPERATIONS

The Association operates in New Zealand within the breeding sector of the thoroughbred racing industry.

NOTE 5: NEW ZEALAND THOROUGHBRED MARKETING LIMITED

In 1998 New Zealand Thoroughbred Marketing Limited (NZTM) was established to take over the marketing function previously undertaken by the Association.

NZTM is three fifths owned by the Association, with the other shareholders being NZ Bloodstock Limited and NZ Thoroughbred Racing (formerly NZ Racing Conference).

The investment in this company is not paid up and represents a contingent liability to the Association of \$2 as at 31 March 2017. (2016: \$2)

Legal entitlement to the New Zealand Bloodstock Limited 0.50 percent levy from the sale of thoroughbreds in NZ is held by the Association. The Council has agreed however to pass this revenue on to NZTM to be used for marketing purposes by that company.

At year end any amounts receivable from NZ Bloodstock Limited are in turn due to NZTM under the above arrangement. They therefore have no impact on the results of the Association and have not been recognised in the Statement of Financial Position.

NOTE 6: CONTINGENCIES

As stated in Note 5 above, the Association has a contingent liability for its unpaid capital investment in NZ Thoroughbred Marketing Limited of \$2. There are no other contingent liabilities at 31 March 2017 (2016: \$Nil).

The Association is involved in a joint venture with Professional Printing and Systems Ltd which is part-owned by the family of Immediate Past President, the late Peter Francis. The joint venture produces and publishes the annual Register of Thoroughbred Stallions of New Zealand. Thoroughbred Publications Ltd is also part-owned by the Francis family and produces the annual A-Z Thoroughbred Business Diary and the New Zealand Racing Annual which are purchased by the Association for distribution to the members.

NOTE 9: LEASE COMMITMENT

Lease commitments included a copier last year however the lease has now expired and a new contract is currently being negotiated.
